Filming Location 4 Fujiidera Temple



Founded in the early 7th century, Fujiidera Temple is believed to have been established as the clan temple of the Fujii clan, a group of immigrants from Baekje. It is one of the Saigoku 33 Kannon Pilgrimage sites. From late April to early May each year, the temple's wisteria trellises bloom in full glory, creating a breathtaking sight. Within the temple grounds, visitors can also enjoy sweets at Vikrida Samade Kiriku.

The library corner boasts an impressive collection of around 7,000 books! Right next door, there's a rest and infant area, making it a welcoming spot for families with young children.



A massive kofun diorama brings the World Heritage-listed Mozu-Furuichi Kofun Group to life! Get an up-close look and feel the impressive scale of these ancient tombs.

Even modern visitors find it soothing?! The star of the haniwa world—the waterfowl-shaped haniwa! The waterfowl-shaped haniwa is a must-see—it even inspired the "Mizudori Haniwa" character, which became a local hometown tax return gift item! Excavated from Tsudo-Shiroyama Kofun, it is one of the largest and oldest waterfowl-shaped haniwa ever discovered. Its remarkable realism has earned it a designation as an Important Cultural Property.




Fujiidera Ichibangai Shopping Arcade
Fujiidera Ichibangai Shopping Arcade, as seen in the filming! With its nostalgic retro atmosphere and warm, welcoming shop owners, it's an amazing place full of charm!

Explore the area with ease using a bicycle-sharing service!
Walking is great, but using one of the 22 bicycle-sharing stations across the city makes getting around even easier! Rent a bicycle and explore Fujiidera at your own pace—riding through the city with the breeze in your hair is the perfect way to see the sights!

Furuichi Kofun Group
Together with the Mozu Kofun Group in Sakai City, the Furuichi Kofun Group became the first World Cultural Heritage site in Osaka. It consists of 30 keyhole-shaped kofun, 39 round kofun, 52 square kofun, and 9 kofun with unidentified shapes, totaling 130 burial mounds. Exploring the area and finding your favorite kofun could be a fun adventure!

Domyoji Temple
The Haji-dera Temple, established in the mid-7th century as the clan temple of the Haji clan, later became a nunnery. It is also known as a place deeply connected to Sugawara no Michizane, who considered it his second home.

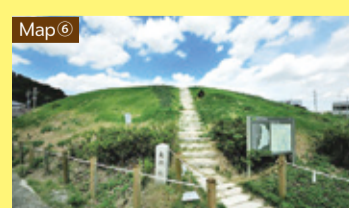
Karakuni Shrine
Karakuni Shrine is an ancient Shikinaisha shrine, mentioned in the Heian-period document Engishiki. Surrounded by lush greenery, its long approach path has been recognized as one of the "Top 100 Green Landscapes of Osaka" for its scenic beauty.

Domyoji Tenmangu Shrine
This shrine is dedicated to Sugawara no Michizane and houses a treasure hall featuring his personal artifacts along with many other valuable cultural properties. It is also famous as a plum blossom viewing spot, with approximately 80 varieties and 800 trees planted on the grounds.

Tomabayashinouji Shrine
Tomabayashinouji Shrine is a historic shrine, recorded in the Heian-period document Engishiki. Its modern shrine buildings, featuring a dignified exterior and refined architectural details, have been designated as Registered Tangible Cultural Properties.

Tsudo-Shiroyama Kofun
Built in the late 4th century, Tsudo-Shiroyama Kofun is the oldest large-scale keyhole-shaped burial mound in the Furuichi Kofun Group. The site is beautifully adorned with seasonal flowers throughout the year.

Nabezuka Kofun
Located near Kintetsu Hajinosato Station, this square-shaped burial mound measures 63 meters on each side and is considered an associated tomb of the Nakatsuhime-no-Mikoto Kofun.

Komuroyama Kofun
A keyhole-shaped burial mound built in the late 4th century, where visitors can walk up to the top and enjoy a stunning panoramic view.
